## Types of Mooring Balls



### Private Moorings (Ours Are Yellow)

These moorings are privately owned and may only be used with the owner's permission.



### Day-Use Moorings

Intended for daytime use only and must be vacated before evening. These are commonly found in dive and snorkel areas. (The closest to CIBC are at Haul Over Bay and Salt Island.)



### Reservable Moorings (Orange or Red)

These moorings can be reserved through the BoatyBall website.

- Reserve according to your BoatyBall membership privileges.
- Please tie only to the mooring assigned to your vessel.



### First Come, First Served (FCFS) Moorings (White)

These moorings are available to the first vessel that arrives, secures to the ball, and completes payment.

After securing to a FCFS mooring:

1. Log in to the BoatyBall app or website.
2. Select the blue mooring corresponding to your location.
3. Confirm your vessel is attached to the FCFS mooring.
4. Complete payment through the App, website or for our bay,

# Yachtsmen Etiquette

- Look for the BoatyBall sticker to identify participating moorings.
  - Do not occupy a mooring reserved for another vessel.
    - Moorings are not transferable between boats.
    - FCFS moorings cannot be held for vessels arriving later.
  - Do not place dinghies, gear, or personal items on a mooring to reserve it.
  - Do not tie to a mooring where there is a dinghy occupying it , (you may not know the circumstance).
- Secure your vessel properly using two bow lines and keep pennants no longer than 3 or 4 feet to reduce swinging and prevent collisions.
- Once you leave a FCFS mooring, it becomes available to others.
- Standard checkout time is 12:00 PM. If you wish to stay longer or another night, please arrange payment promptly.
  - Maintain slow speed and no-wake operation throughout the mooring field.
    - Always be on the lookout for swimmers & snorkelers.
- Use onboard holding tanks as dictated by maritime law. Do NOT discharge in mooring fields, or near beaches, snorkel or dive sites.
  - Do not throw food or waste overboard in the mooring field, even if it is biodegradable.
